IS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST LAND REGULATIONS.

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dostrotte District. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions.
