As the Crovincial Government are charged with the cost of maintain. ing peace they would be glad, I imaging to allow the officer acting for the How Luft General to allot reserves or small fishery streams whenever recasion re-- quired it, and the demands for this would be so slow that it is not likely an expressive Commission for the purpose would become necessary. At the present time I think reserves should be made as alberni, where there is considerable farm - ing land and already some eight or nine white settlers! at knights Inlet and the Hass where so many Inaians congregate for obtaining their annual supply of "Small fish oil," and the village sites at Simpson and Mella-· habtle ought so be secured to the on-- draw having property upon them. all the remaining points on the extensive Coast line could be at - hended to as occasion required, because there are no white men to interfere with the oridians and not likely to be pending the developement here and there of some mining, Fishery or manufacturing inaustry, The boast ought not to be compared with the Interior in respect to the necessity of a general and
