County Court.
The case of Peters vs. Parker went to
the jury yesterday afternoon. After an
absence of two hours the jury returned
and said they could not agree. They were
reconvened for today.

The grand jury returned a true bill
against James Armstrong, indicted for
shooting James Sheridan. The prisoner
pleaded not guilty and was remanded.
Michael Nugent vs. Dennis Driscoll
was then taken up. I. Allen Jack, Esq.,
appeared for the plaintiff, and C. N. Skir-
ner, Esq., for the defendant. After the
plaintiff's evidence Mr. Skirner moved
for a non-suit and Mr. Jack replied. The
Judge refused to grant the non-suit.
Driscoll gave his testimony this morning,
this time with success, as the Judge
decided to grant it.

Alex. Christie et al. vs. Geo. Bishop et al
was the next case. J. R. Armstrong for
plaintiff. This case was put off on ac-
count of the absence of Bishop, a material
witness.

Levi Harrington vs. Andrew Neal was
taken up about 12 o'clock, and the plain-
tiff was giving his testimony when the
Court adjourned. Mr. Skirner ap-
peared for the plaintiff, and C. N. Skirner,
Esq., for the defence.

City Police Court.
There was only one prisoner this morn-
ing. Patrick Kennedy, who was charged
with being drunk and disorderly on Brus-
sels street. He was fined \$6.

Portland Police Court.
A complicated case of abusive language
occupied the attention of the court this
morning. The litigants were the two
women from Cedar Point, across the river
from Indianapolis. Mrs. Ellen Covey, an-
dressed in black, was accused by Miss Mary Ann
Covegrove, a maiden of about twenty-five
summers, with using very abusive lan-
guage and casting serious reflections on
her character. The charge was proved
and Mrs. Covey had to pay \$4 and cost.
Miss Covegrove was then accused with
using abusive language. The Magis-
trate dismissed the charge against her,
compelling her to pay \$2.50 costs, as he
told her that she did not come to court
with the clean hands, and also gave
her some excellent advice. The services
of Mr. John Kerr, the portly
Portland Police practitioner, deserve
special mention in the case. He ap-
peared to be more like an associate Judge
than a counsel, and it was very refresh-
ing in the heated court room to hear the
fatherly and patronizing way, while pre-
siding for his client, in which he gave gra-
tuitous advice to all including the Magis-
trate. His Honor condescendingly al-
lowed him to have his say as it was par-
ticularly amusing to the spectators pre-
sent, and then decided the case on its
merits.

Margaret Ryan went to the Station for
protection and was allowed to depart in
peace.

Sarah Bennett was accused with as-
saulting Letitia Penstock. The charge
was withdrawn on payment of costs.
