THE DISTINCTIVE PRINCIPLES of this College, which are the basis of the instruction given, are:—

THE BIBLE, THE SOLE RULE OF FAITH; in opposition to the error that would make the Bible and tradition the *joint* rule of faith.

“Holy Scriptures containeth all things necessary to salvation, so that whatsoever is not read therein, nor may be proved thereby, is not to be required of any man, that it should be believed as an article of the faith, or be thought requisite or necessary to salvation.”—*Article VI.*
