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THE DISTINCTIVE PRINCIPLES of this College, which are the basis of the instruction given, are :—

THE BIBLE, THE SOLE RULE OF FAITH; in opposition to the error that would make the Bible and tradition the *joint* rule of faith.

"Holy Scriptures containeth all things necessary to salvation, so that *whatsoever is not read therein, nor may be proved thereby*, is not to be required of any man, that it should be believed as an article of the faith, or be thought requisite or necessary to salvation."—*Article VI.*

2. JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH IN CHRIST ALONE; in opposition to the sacramentarian system.
