THE LAURENTIDE PAPER COMPANY's annual report showed that profits for the year eading June 30, amounted to \$283,321 after providing for interest and contingent accounts. From these profits the company paid dividends of 7 p.c. on preference and 6 p.c. on common stock, aggregating \$180,000, while \$20,000 had been carried forward to depreciation reserve, leaving a balance of \$83,321 to be carried forward.

The marked feature of the report was the reduction of \$474,000 in the company's obligation to the bank, which was attributed to the improved handing of the company's log supply. After making allowances for all liabilities, the financial statement showed a surplus of \$242,067, with assets of \$5,159,843 and total liabilities of \$4,916,876.
