Militia. Has been Coroner for the Co. for over 20 years; and Health officer for Liverpool and the Co. for a longer period. Elected Presdt. Bank of Liverpool, 1874. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at g.e., 1867; re-elected by acclamation, at g.e., 1872, and at last g.e., "His political views are, as they have always been, independent, and he is an advocate of the independence of Can. at an early day."—*Liverpool, N.S.*

FOURNIER, Hon. TELESOPHORE, Q.C. (*Bellechasse.*)

B. at St. François, Riviere du Sud, Montmagny, P.Q., 1824. Ed. at Nicolet College. M., 1857. Miss Demers. Called to the Bar, L.C., 1846. Created Q.C., 1863. Has been *Bâtonnier* of the Quebec Bar, and Presdt. of the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec. Was one of the Editors of *Le National* newspaper (Quebec.) Contested Quebec unsuccessfully for the Can. Assembly at g.e., 1857. First returned to Parlt. for present seat, by acclamation, August, 1870, on resignation of
