BILL

To give further power to the Executive Government, to prevent the introduction or spreading of Infectious or Contagious diseases.

Preamble.

MTHEREAS by reason of the great influx of Emigrants from the United-Kingdom, in confined and unhealthy vessels, infectious or contagious diseases may be generated in the passage to this Province, it is therefore necessary to give further powers to the Executive Government, to prevent the introduction or spreading of such infectious or Contagious Diseases, than are provided for by the Act of the thirty-fifth of his late Majesty, chapter fitth, intituled, "An Act to " oblige ships and vessels coming from pla-" ces infected with the plague or any pesti-" lential fever or disease, to perform qua-" rantine, and prevent the communication " thereof in this Province;"—Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great-Britain, intituled, " An "Act to repeal certain parts of an Act "passed in the fourteenth year of His " Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for " making more effectual provision for the "Government of the Province of Quebec, in " North America," and to make further pro-"vision for the Government of the said "Province;" and it is hereby enacted, by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for his Excellency the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor or person administering the Government of this Protime to time to vince, for the time being, by and with the give such the advice and consent of his Majesty's Execu-lus pecture, of tive Council for this Province, to give such as may appear expedi-cut to obtain information of the Inspector of the Port, or other person or the health of persons to be by his Excellency appointed,
