1 **W**HEREAS in the present State of the Province of *Lower*  
*Canada* the House of Assembly of the said Province, con-  
stituted under the Act passed in the Thirty-first Year of  
His Majesty King *George* the Third, intituled *An Act to repeal* 31 G. 3. c. 31.  
*certain Parts of an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's*  
*Reign, intituled 'An Act for making more effectual Provision for the*  
*' Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to*  
*' make further Provision for the Government of the said Province,*  
cannot be called together without serious Detriment to the Interests  
of the said Province, by reason whereof the Government of the said  
Province cannot be duly administered according to the Provisions of  
the said Act: And whereas it is expedient to make temporary Pro-  
vision for the Government of *Lower Canada*, in order that Parliament
