### University Affairs

Plagiarism is currently one of the hottest topics within the university. The majority of the cases brought to the Student Standings and Promotions (SS&P) committee lately are all in some way related to the issue of plagiarism. The variations are found in whether the plagiarism was intentional or not deliberate.

The UNB Calendar defines plagiarism in many different forms but acknowledges that it is an academic offence. It includes, but is not limited to:

- quoting verbatim or almost verbatim from a source (such as copyrighted material, notes, letters, business entries, etc.) without acknowledging this to be a quotation;
- taking over someone else's line of thought, argument, arrangement, and supporting evidence (such as, for example, statistics, bibliographies, etc.) without indicating such dependence;
- submitting someone else's work, in whatever form (film, workbook, artwork, etc.) without acknowledgement;
- representing as one's own in any academic work submitted for credit in a course or program of study, any idea or expression of an idea of another.

So there you have it. Plagiarism at its finest. Most of the decisions regarding plagiarism are made by deciding whether it was simply a genuine misunderstanding or not. SS&P is after all not a court of law but a committee that makes decisions based on the balance of probability.
