My Dear Sir I have the honor of transmitting to you herewith
an extract of a Letter from Colonel Darling, Dated, "Lutwick, 21st Novr. 1823,"
authorizing the employment of an Amouneur at York, and Amherstburgh,
for the Repair of Indian Guns &c.

And I beg leave to call your attention to the
accompanying Extract of a Letter, also from Colonel Darling, Dated "Lutwick
27th October 1823," and request you will be so good as to inform me
what Day in the Year would be the most convenient for assembling
the Wounded Indians, at Fort George, Spessum, instead of Kingston,
for the purpose of their examination before a Medical Board; and how
far the observations contained in this Extract, apply to the Wounded
Pensioners in Upper Canada.

Will you also have the goodness
to forward to me as soon as possible the Statements required by
