IMPERIAL INSTITUTE GRANT
ESTIMATES 1925: Vote 343. - \$12,849.

As originally submitted to Council, this vote amounted in the aggregate to \$14,797., made up as follows:

Grant to Imp.Inst.: \(\frac{1}{2}\)000 equals \(\frac{1}{9}\),740. Grant re Galleries: \(\frac{1}{2}\)040 " \(\frac{5}{4}\),797.

Following receipt of Mr. Larkin's cable of February 19th. and the Colonial Secretary's cable of February 22nd., it was decided in Council to reduce the amount allocated for retention of the galleries by £400 equals \$1,948. This left the total vote as it now stands in the Estimates, namely £2640 equals \$12,849

made up as follows:

Grant to Impl Inst.: \(\frac{1}{2}\)2000 equals \(\frac{9}{9}\),740. Grant re Galleries : \(\frac{1}{6}\)40 \(\frac{1}{2}\)540 \(\frac{1}{2}\),849.
