was a charge for 3200 feet of flooringat \$25.00 per thousand (\$80.00). According to a letter from dated the 25th July last the \$112.00 claimed is for 3200 feet flooring at \$35.00 per thousand. If the firm still maintain that they supplied additional lumber to that paid for, and if they render their account supported by a shipping billior receipt, which they claim they can produce, showing delivery of the flooring at Metlakahtla, you may certify the said account and forward to the Department, through the Indian Superintendent, and the matter of payment will, when the account is received here, be given consideration.
