Referring to your letter of the IIth. inst., relating to the damages to certain lands in the Sarris Indian Reserve, caused by the construction of the new out-off drain, I have to request you to keep this matter in view, in order to have it closed at the earliest convenient date.

The intention of the Sarnin Council to have valuations made of the demages sustained, appears to be the ourrest course. The awards should be submitted to you, and if you consider them to be entisfactory, you should forward them to the Department for approval.

It would probably faciliate matters if you were to not in concert with the valuators, and time arrive at valuations that rould be mutually satisfactory.
