Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 11th. inst., relating to the damages to certain lands in the Sarnia Indian Reserve, caused by the construction of the new cut-off drain, I have to request you to keep this matter in view, in order to have it closed at the earliest convenient date.

The intention of the Sarnia Council to have valuations made of the damages sustained, appears to be the correct course. The awards should be submitted to you, and if you consider them to be satisfactory, you should forward them to the Department for approval.

It would probably facilitate matters if you were to act in concert with the valuers, and thus arrive at valuations that would be mutually satisfactory.
