


Ottawa, 7th December, 1910.

With reference to your recent letter regarding  
amounts due you by certain Indians of the Rama Reserve,  
I transmit herewith a statement showing the names  
of the Indians who are indebted to you and the balance which  
they still owe. Collections towards the liquidation of the  
question, are being made as agreed upon at the time  
of settlement. The amount distributed per capita, to mem-  
bers of the Rama Band, is small, it is therefore not likely  
that the Indians indebted to you would consent to larger  
amounts being deducted from their interest money for settle-  
ment of their accounts.
