British Empire, restricted to non-commissioned officers and men below warrant rank for specially distinguished or meritorious service.

3. AWARDS MADE TO OTHER PARTS OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE.

The following appointments to Orders of Chivalry or Mentions in Despatches were published:

- 15 Commanders of the O.B.E. (Military).
- 48 Officers of the O.B.E. (Military), including officers of Australian, New Zealand Indian Forces.
- 75 Members of the O.B.E. (Military), including officers and warrant officers of Australian, New Zealand and Indian Forces.
- 19 Medels of the Order of the British Empire for meritorious service, (exclusive of two awards to Canadian Army personnel referred to).

The above do not include Peerages (Field Marshal Sir W.E. Ironside), awards to civilians, Navy or Air Force, or awards for gallantry.
