On Thursday evening 29 July 43 I  
spent the evening with Cpts Duller and  
Miles in Darnham. We were drinking  
from approximately 1930 until 2200 hrs.  
About midnight we picked up Dr. Swords  
at Darnham station and proceeded back  
to Bordon. I was driving in the front  
seat and the first I knew of any difference  
was after we had left Wrecclesham when  
I heard an animated conversation between  
Cpts Duller and Miles. I do not know  
what had started it. As it was between  
two Cpts I did not intervene or interfere.  
Coming into Bordon we had directed the  
driver to Brocas House but on Cpt Duller's  
instructions we proceeded to Camber House.  
On our arrival there Cpt Miles left the  
car with Cpt Duller following. The car  
was turned around. I saw Cpts Duller  
and Miles talking at the foot of the  
stairs in the hall. He waited a couple  
of minutes then drove away.
