

Application for entry moses be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is situate. Entry by proxy, may, however, be made at any Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of an intending homesteader.

DUTIES.—(1) At least six months' residence upon and cul-tivation of the land in each year for three years.

(2) A homesteader may, if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eight, (89) acree in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. He may also do so by living with father or mother, on certain conditions. Joint ownershit in land will not meet this requirement. quirement.

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farm-ing land owned by himself must notify the agent for the district of such intention.
