St. Paul's, Erie, Pa., celebrated its eightieth anniversary on St. Patrick's Day.

An oak pulpit beautifully carved is to be placed shortly after Easter in the fine old parish church of Ashburton, Devon.

The consecration of Canon Lander, vicar of St. Cyprian's, Edgehill, Liverpool, to the Bishopric of Victoria, Hong Kong, will take place in July.

A Tectern Bible has been presented to the Church of the Ascension, St. Louis, Miss., by Mrs. H. T. Simmonds. It is a memorial gift and is beautifully bound.

The Rev. Dr. A. A. Morrison, rector of Trinity Church, Portland, Ore., was presented on a recent birthday with a life insurance policy for \$5,000, the gift of six laymen.

St. Luke's Cathedral, of the Diocese of Maine, has been enriched by the gift of a fine altar cross from the Bishop, and two brass candlesticks, which were given by the family of the late Mr. George B. Jackson.

At the last monthly meeting of the S. P. C. K. grants amounting to £12,103 were made. Of this sum £10,500 was given to Canada for the furtherance of the work of the Church chiefly in the Far North and the N. W. T.

A record is held by the Rev. E. Clapton, vicar of Stebbing, Essex. On a recent Sunday he assisted to ring a peal of 720 changes on the bells before church. After this he conducted the whole service, preached the sermon, and played the organ.

St. Giles' Church, Colchester, which holds the remains of two valiant knights, who were shot by Fairfax after the siege of Colchester, is to be restored at a cost of £3,000. The Bishop of Colchester has offered to give £50 a year for life to the fund.
