the more eafy discovery and effectual punishment of buyers and receivers of Stolen Goods and Monies, in cases of Petty Larceny, and in other cases;" to which they defire the concurrence of the House of Assembly. And also,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled, "An Act for preventing the forging and counterfeiting of Foreign Bills of Exchange, and of Foreign Promissory Notes and Orders for the payment of Money;" to which they defire the concurrence of the House of Assembly. And allo,

The Legislative Council have passed a Bill, intituled, "An Act to prevent the abuse of oppositions afin d'annuller, afin de distraire, and afin de charge;" to which they defire the concurrence of the House of Affembly.

And then he withdrew:

And then the faid engroffed Bills were feverally read for the first time.

A Bill for the relief of the Poor, in the Loan of Seed Wheat, Corn, and other neceffary Grain, was, according to order, read a fecond time.

Mr. Debartzch moved, seconded by Mr. Larue ;

That the faid Bill be referred to a Special Committee of five Members.

The House divided on the question :

## Yeas 10 Nays 26

So it passed in the negative.

Mr. Bourdages moved, seconded by Mr. Durocher;

That the blank in the Bill be filled with the words, "first day of July next." The
