Voted, That there be paid out of the public Money in the Treafury to the feveral under-mentioned Perfons for the Services and Purpofes following, *viz.*

To the Rev. Mr. *Wood*, for his Services as Chaplain to the Houfe this Seffion, - - - - £4. 10.

To Mr. JOHN KENT, Meflenger and Door-Keeper of this Houfe, for his Attendance and Services, - - - £7. 10.

To Mr. *Anthony Henry*, for printing the Votes of this Houfe, and for Stationary fupplied, - - - £13. 18.

Refolution concerning Collection of Duties at *Halifax*.

Resolved, That Mr. Speaker do wait on his Honor the Lieut. Governor to acquaint his Honor that the Houfe being of opinion that one Collector is fufficient to Collect the Duties at *Halifax*, do beg leave to recommend Mr. *Hinsbelwood* to Act in that Office.

Bills affented to.

And Mr. Speaker with the Houfe having attended accordingly, his Honor was pleafed to give his Affent to the following Bills, *viz.*

A Bill declaring what fhall be deemed merchantable Timber for Exportation to *Great-Britain*.

A Bill in further Amendment of and in Addition to an Act made in the 32d Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, **An Act for confirming Titles to Lands and quieting Poffeffions.**

A Bill in further Amendment of, and Addition to an Act made in the 3d Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled, **an Act to enable the feveral Townfhips within this Province to maintain their Poor.**

A Bill to repeal two Acts made in the 10th and 11th Years of His prefent Majesty's Reign, to enable the feveral Counties in this Province to raife Money for Payment of their Representatives.

A Bill for raifing a Fund for the Purpofe of making and repairing Bridges and Roads of Communication thro' the Province.

General Affembly prorogued.

Then the Clerk of the Council by his Honor's Command, declared the General Affembly prorogued to Monday the 17th Day of *Auguft* next, and the fame was prorogued accordingly.
