

“ *Towns or Parishes in this Province and for repealing all the Laws now in force relating to the same*”—and stated the substance of the said conference to the House.

The bill “ *Declaratory of what Acts of Parliament are binding in this Province*” being read as reported by the committee of the whole House yesterday—Ordered, That the same be re-committed. Bill read as reported,
and committed.
