Watch the current and groseber bushes, and on the first appearance of the current worms kill them with white the currant worms kill them with white hellebore, by duating very thinly over the leaves from a fine dredging-box. Or the hellebore may be applied with water, by first wetting a spoonful with a p^tnt of water and thoroughly mixing it, and then adding a gallon or two of water and stirring thoroughly. Apply to every part of the bushes with a watering pot, repeating as often as necessary. If not promptly destroyed on their first appearance, the worms will soon strip the bushes, and if this stripping is many times repeated it will destroy them. A prompt use of the hellebore will preserve a full mass of foliage and a heavy crop of fruit.

Spray every tree in apple orchards with Paris green to kill the codling worm when the young fruit is the size of cherries, and repeat it. The crep is too small this year in most localities to lose any of it by these destroyers. Mix a small tablespoonful of the poison in a three-gallon pail of water, and syrings it over the trees. It will be all washed off by trains long before the fruit is grown, and the codling worms will be killed by it.

Destroy the curculio, beginning as soon as the blossoms drop. By the mode high we have often described, the crop may be saved from this insect with absolute certainty, and with a small amount of labor. Cut away all portions of plum trees which show indications of the black knot, and by vigilance they may be kept free from it with little labor.

As soon as young raspberry and blackberi / canes reach a height of about three feet, stop their grow. a by pinching, and repeat the process some weeks afterwards on the side shoots when they are a feet or two in length. This operation forms compact oushes which bear heavier and require no staking.

Things which You Must not Do.—Do not attempt to put back the shots which form the heads of newly set trees, after the buds have opened, as this checks the growth. If this work has not been done while the trees were yet in bud, and the tops are too heaver, stake them to prevent one waying about by wind. Never cut back young heads of trees just after growth has started, unless they are too rampant and you wish to check them. 




