The Government of Canada and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany,

Conscious of their obligations under the North Atlantic Treaty of 4 April 1949,

Convinced that the defence capabilities of the North Atlantic Alliance will be enhanced by Host Nation Support during times of crisis or war,

Under the provisions of the Agreement of 19 June 1951 between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty Regarding the Status of their Forces (NATO SOFA) and the Agreement of 3 August 1959 to Supplement the Agreement between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces with respect to Foreign Forces stationed in the Federal Republic of Germany (Supplementary Agreement),

Have agreed as follows:
