My Government understands that the third paragraph of the above-mentioned Note of August 23, 1960, is not intended to eliminate the responsibility of the Canadian Government to save the United States Government harmless in respect of claims asserted by third parties arising out of the operation of the vessel by Canada, and on this premise agrees with the understanding which was expressed in the said Note.
