

And The House having continued to sit until after 12 of the clock, midnight;

WEDNESDAY, 16th MARCH, 1881.

Report to be received,—and Committee to sit again, at the next sitting of The House, *this day*.

Sir *John A. Macdonald* moved, that the Bill No. 77 to amend the Dominion Lands Acts, be now read a third time.

Mr. *Mills* moved in amendment thereto, that the Bill be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole with instructions that they have power to amend Clause 4. by providing a limitation of the area of land, which may be sold by the Government to one person; which was negatived on a division.

Mr. *Charlton* then moved in amendment, that the Bill be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole with instructions that they have power to amend Clause 4 by enacting, that except where otherwise provided by Resolution of this House, all lands shall be disposed of subject to conditions of actual settlement; which was negatived on a division.

Mr. *Holton* then moved in amendment, that the Bill be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole with instructions that they have power to amend Clause 4 by providing that the unappropriated even numbered Sections in each Township shall be disposed of only upon condition of actual settlement; which was negatived on a division.

Mr. *Blake* then moved in amendment, that the Bill be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole with instructions that they have power to amend Clause 4 by providing that the price of Dominion lands sold without conditions of settlement, shall be payable in cash at the time of sale; which was negatived on a division.

The main motion was then agreed to, and the Bill accordingly read a third time, and passed.

The Resolutions adopted in Committee of *Supply* on the 1st instant, were reported, read a second time, and concurred in, and are as follows:—
