## MOTIONS.

For Monday, 14th May, 1883.

By the Honorable Mr. Power :—

1883.

- 1 May 11—That when the Order of the Day is called for the Third Reading of the Bill intituled: “ An Act further to amend, and to consolidate as amended, the several Acts respecting the Public Lands of the Dominion therein mentioned,” he will move “ That the said Bill be not now read a third time, but that it be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House, with instructions to amend the said Bill by adding the following sub-section to “ the Thirty-first clause ” :—
- “ (4.) Provided also that the *bond fide* cultivation of fifteen acres of such land by the person who has obtained a homestead entry therefor, shall be accepted as an equivalent for the term of “ residence hereby required during the first year after entry ; ”

By the Honorable Mr. Power :—

- 2 “ 11—That when the Order of the Day is called for the Third Reading of the Bill intituled : “ An Act further to amend, and to consolidate as amended, the several Acts respecting the Public Lands of the Dominion therein mentioned,” he will move “ That the said Bill be not now read a third time, but that it be re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House, with instructions to amend the said Bill by leaving out the words ‘ after three “ years residence, ’ in the second line of the Thirty-seventh clause.”
