

to the support of the ministry and their families; that this mixed Joint-Committee shall report as early as possible to the Executive Committee of the Conference, who shall be instructed, if they deem it expedient, to lay the same before the Quarterly Meeting of each Circuit; the vote of concurrence or non-concurrence to be reported to the next Conference.

In conclusion, the Committee is fully persuaded that the ministerial brethren of the Canada Conference will receive, with candour and kindness, this imperfect embodiment of the feeling and sentiment that prevailed in the meeting which deputed to them this duty and responsibility. Having given to the subject a careful consideration, the Committee begs leave most respectfully to submit its views, with an humble prayer, that the Great Head of the Church may direct all your counsels for his own glory, by the spread of scriptural holiness throughout the land.
