

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-197.

An Act for the relief of Roslyn Isaacs.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Roslyn Isaacs, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of William Isaacs, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twenty-eighth day of February, A.D. 1960, at the said city, she then being Roslyn Shuster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence ad-
duced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be
granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice
and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of
Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage
dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
