



Post Boring Machine for Furniture Work.

THIS Machine is specially designed for any kind of Furniture or other Factory, where a simple, cheap and efficient Boring Machine is required. It is built on a square wooden column, and, being self-contained with countershaft, is complete in itself.

The Table is made to adjust up or down on the column, with hand wheel and ratchet, to suit different thicknesses of stock.

The Spindle is driven by belt from countershaft, as seen in cut, and is pulled down to its work by a foot treadle, leaving the hands of the operator free to handle the work, and is drawn back to its place by a steel spring. It is also supplied with stop-gauge by which it is regulated to required depth of hole.

A number of these machines are now being used in some of the largest furniture factories in the country and are giving unqualified satisfaction. The extensive works of James Hay & Co., Woodstock, Ont., are running seven of these machines.

Tight and loose Pulleys are 8 in. dia. by 4 in. face, and should make 700 revolutions per minute.
