THE GAS COMPANY'S APPEAL

Mr. Johnston Got the Worst of It From the Law Lords.

Full Text of the Judgment Delivered by the Privy Council in the Case Which Has Been Followed With So Much Interest by Torontonians—The Arguments Advanced Reviewed.

The judgment of the Privy Council in the case of J. T. Johnston, against the Consumers' Gas Company, appears in full below:

The appeal was from the judgment of the Court of Appeal, reversing the decision of Mr. Justice Ferguson at the trial, which was in favor of Mr. Johnston upon all points. The decision of the law lords is practically upon the line of that of the Court of Appeal, and, as did the Ontario court, that Mr. Johnston, in himself and his company, had no right of action, and that the company was not liable to be established for the gas supply of the city of Toronto.

The respondents, the Consumers' Gas Company of Toronto, were incorporated in 1887 by an act of the Parliament of Canada, 11 Viet. cap. 14.
