CHARGES FOR STORAGE IN THE CUSTOM HOUSE STORES, QUEBEC.

Act 10 and 11 Victoria, Cap. 31.

Section 30.—All charges incurred on Goods for landing, cartage, storage, unpacking, repacking, weighing or guaging, paid, in order to carry this Act into effect, shall be at the expense of the Importer of such Goods.

One package at least in each Invoice to be opened, or more if necessary; and in case of suspicion or fraud, the whole to be opened.
