Geneva, March 29.—An order of expulsion from the Geneva canton issued against a French woman will not be carried out, the woman, who is less than thirty years old, cleverly outwitting the police. She visited a local hospital and inquired whether there was an incurable or dying Genevese patient. A nurse introduced the woman to John Baudit, fifty-nine years old, who was in the last stages of tuberculosis. He agreed to marry the woman in consideration of thirty dollars cash and ten dollars monthly during his life.

The bride presented the poor bridegroom with a new suit of clothes, and the couple drove in an automobile to the registry office, where the marriage ceremony was performed.

The bridegroom returned to the hospital and the bride to her apartments. They may never see one another again, but the bride is now a Genevese and cannot be expelled.




