**THREE ATTEMPTS TO BURN QUEBEC CATHOLIC COLLEGE**  
Longueuil Superiors in a State of Terror Place Their Case in Hands of the Town Authorities

Montreal, June 9—Mystified by three deliberate attempts of a firebug to burn St. Joseph's Academy and Sacred Heart College, Longueuil, the superiors and students of these institutions have been in a terrorized state for the last week.  
No motive for the repeated attempts to destroy the Catholic institutions is known. Determined to get at the bottom of the mystery, Rev. Brother Terullien, of the Sacred Heart College, has asked the authorities of the town an official investigation.  
There are nearly 500 resident pupils at Sacred Heart College.

**Likely to Pay Dollar for Dollar**  
London, June 9—The double failure of Chaplin, Milne, Grenfell and Company and the Canadian Agency, although much discussed yesterday, has not raised any serious fears of further trouble on the stock exchange, although there were hints of some difficulty attaching to one of the group which took over St. Grenell's commitments. The failure of Chaplin, Milne, Grenfell and Company does not affect the exchange directly, as it was an outside firm.  
The Financial Times suggests that the importance of the case was greatly overrated, and states that its affairs had been the talk of the money market for some months. All the papers, in their drawl of acceptance bearing the company's name, for several weeks past. The general belief that the company will ultimately settle at twenty shillings on the pound, as the realization of the assets will offer little probability. The crash of the Canadian Agency seems to have upset the city more.

Since the introduction of the new city court act, the business of the city court has been greatly retarded by the resignation of Captain McIntyre, who protested against the extra work imposed upon him. All the papers in connection with the city court matters now have to be issued by police clerks George A. Henderson, and the constables are kept waiting every morning for their summons. They have now taken strenuous objection to this and have refused to handle any more of the business until a new deputy has been appointed.
