RULE OF TERROR

Duchess Writes of Investigations—
"No God; No Religion" Badge of School Children

London, April 7—The Daily Mail gives prominence to an article by Adeline, Duchess of Bedford, based on personal investigations in Portugal. She alleges that Portugal is groaning under terrorism which recalls the conditions in Naples and Sicily in the worst days of Bomba.

The duchess writes:—"There are spies in every household, the story that walls have ears and every window is an eye of justice and truth plays no part where convictions are determined beforehand. False witnesses can be had for the asking and acquittal might be followed by murder.

"These statements are not denied by a large section of the republican party, but it is helpless and completely at the mercy of an all powerful secret society. The prisons at Lisbon and the provinces are crowded with suspects of every class, the great bulk of whom have not been tried, and it is well known that the judges repair from the provinces to Lisbon to receive orders before passing sentences. A very low class of men spend the days loitering outside the courts prepared to swear to any false accusation in accordance to the amount of fee they receive."

Referring to the suppression of the church, the duchess says: "The name of God is forbidden in the republic. The republic has definitely undertaken the extinction of the Christian faith. The children in the schools are decorated with little badges bearing the words: 'No God
