	1. By V. W. Bro. J. Parker Thomas,—That section 116 (on page 46) of the Constitution be amended by adding the word "five" in the second line after the word "twenty" and before the word "dollars," making the sum for initiation twenty-five dollars (instead of twenty dollars) as the minimum consideration for which a Lodge shall make a Mason..... 160
	2. By V. W. Bro. J. A. Wills,—That no Lodge shall permit to be used in any room used by them for either Hall, Lodge-room, or at the refreshment table, wines or spirits or other intoxicating liquors..... 160
	3. By V. W. Bro. J. A. Wills,—That section 133 of the Constitution be amended by striking out all after the word "remitted" in the second line..... 160
	4. By M. W. Bro. Daniel Spry,—That article 110 of the Constitution be amended by inserting after the word "days" in the first line, the words, "and hours,"..... 160
	5. By R. W. Bro. Dewitt H. Martin,—That Section 8 "of Grand Lodge" in the Book of Constitution be struck out. 160
	6. By W. Bro. N. McKechnie,—That article 165 of the Constitution be expunged, so that country lodges may have concurrent jurisdiction the same as lodges in towns or cities. 160
