"Poleric" In Flames Is Latest Report

Vessel of Many Trouble Once More Scene of Fire

Boston, March 11.—The British freighter Poteric, more than four months out of Calcutta for this port, is in trouble again. After breaking down in mid-ocean, being towed to the Azores, and catching fire in Poleric was made shipshape once more, fires were extinguished and was ready to proceed when, according to cablegrams today fire appeared again. The previous damage to the cargo was said to be considerable, but number six hold and its contents was kept intact, until the latest fire developed, and it is in that section that the flames are now reported raging.
