## RESENT STORY APPEARING IN LONDON OUTLOOK

**Ex-Premier Meighen Calls It Defamatory to the Honor of Canada.**

Ottawa, March 27.—(Canadian Press.)—On the orders of the day in the House this afternoon, Mr. Meighen drew the attention of the Government to an article appearing in the morning newspapers in regard to the Grand Trunk arbitration proceedings. The article in question, which was, he said, carried over from a British paper, insinuated that it was defamatory to the honor of Canada, he wished to bring it to the attention of the Government and to ask what course would be taken in regard to it.

Mr. Meighen said that, whether or not there was disagreement as to the wisdom of acquiring the Grand Trunk system, he felt sure that there was nothing dishonorable or unfair in the treatment accorded to the Grand Trunk shareholders by the Board of Arbitrators or the Canadian Government. The Government of the country in which a newspaper publishes an article reflecting on the honor of another country exercised some supervision in the matter. He wished to know whether the Government would take action.

Premier King replied that it was a little difficult to determine what course was the best to take in regard to newspaper dispatches. He was quite sure, however, that the remarks of Mr. Meighen would be given wide circulation, and he wished to associate himself with them entirely. That, he thought, would be sufficient.

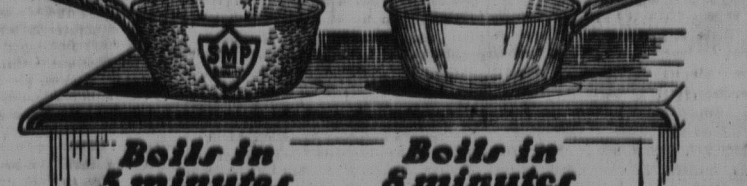
