any such removal, or of death or of resignation of office of the said Clerk, to appoint another in his place; and the Commissioners and their Clerk, shall receive for their 5 services under this Act, and for their necessary expenses and disbursements, such compensation as shall be allowed by the Governor in Council, and no other fees or emoluments whatsoever; and such compensation 10 shall be defrayed out of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund.

IX. And be it enacted, That the amount Amount of of the Debentures to be issued under this &c., not to ex-Act, and the amount of the said compensa- ceed £100,000 15 tion to be allowed to the said Commissioners currency and Clerk, shall not exceed the sum of one hundred thousand pounds currency, which sum shall also include the sum of nine thousand nine hundred and eighty-six pounds, 20 seven shillings and twopence, raised by Debentures issued under the said Act hereinbefore mentioned.

X. XI.
