

any such removal, or of death or of resignation of office of the said Clerk, to appoint another in his place; and the Commissioners and their Clerk, shall receive for their 5 services under this Act, and for their necessary expenses and disbursements, such compensation as shall be allowed by the Governor in Council, and no other fees or emoluments whatsoever; and such compensation 10 shall be defrayed out of the said Consolidated Revenue Fund.

IX. And be it enacted, That the amount of the Debentures to be issued under this Act, and the amount of the said compensation to be allowed to the said Commissioners and Clerk, shall not exceed the sum of one hundred thousand pounds currency, which sum shall also include the sum of nine thousand nine hundred and eighty-six pounds, 20 seven shillings and twopence, raised by Debentures issued under the said Act herembefore mentioned.

Amount of Debentures, &c., not to exceed £100,000 currency

X. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said Commissioners faithfully and without partialty to enquire into and to ascertain the amount of the losses mentioned in the Preamole to this Act, as those for which compensation ought to be made, and to report the same to the Governor 30 of this Province.

Duty of Commissioners.

XI. And be it enacted, That the powers vested in, and duties required of, the said Commissioners, or of any three of them, under this Act, shall also extend and be construed to extend to inquire into all such losses sustained by Her Majesty's subjects and other residents within the said late Province of Lower Canada, and the several claims and demands which have accrued to 40 any such persons by such losses, in respect of any loss, destruction, or damage of property occasioned by violence on the part of persons in Her Majesty's service, or by vio-

Powers vested in Commissioners shall extend in certain cases.
