I have pleasure in informing you that the Canadian Government have this morning voted a sum of \$5000 towards the introduction of reindeer at Harrington. Dr. Grenfell has been made trustee for the Covernment in the natter, and the deer have been introduced at his request as a means of assisting in the work of the mission.

I enclose copy of a letter thich Dr. Grenfell has sent to the Minister of Marine and Fisheries of Canada, and which may be the means of securing a further Covernment grant in aid of the Hospital, though of this I am unable to give any assurance at the present time.
