I have pleasure in informing you that the Canadian Government have this morning voted a sum of \$5000 towards the introduction of reindeer at Harrington. Dr. Grenfell has been made trustee for the Government in the matter, and the deer have been introduced at his request as a means of assisting in the work of the mission.
