the other party to the investigation) and the third on the recommendation of the members so chosen.

For the purpose of appointment of the members of the Board, the following provisions shall apply:-

> (a) The persons upon whose application the order has been granted and the persons named in the order as being concerned in the alleged combine, being respectively the parties to the investigation, may within five days after being requested so to do by the Minister, recommend the name of a person who is willing and ready to act as a member of the Board, and the Minister shall appoint such person a member of the Board.

For the purpose of obtaining from the parties a recommendation of a member of a Board, it shallbe sufficient, as respects the applicants, for the Minister to communicate with the person mentioned in the order as authorized to receive communications on their behalf, and as respects the persons, companies or corporations concerned in the alleged combine, with the person, company or corporation mentioned in the order, as the one with whom the Minister should com-

municate for this purpose.

(b) If either of the parties fails or neglects to make a recommendation within the said period, or such extension thereof as the Minister, on cause shown, grants, the Minister shall, as soon thereafter as possible, appoint a fit person to be a member of the Board; and such member shall be deemed to be appointed on the recommendation of the said party.
