Municipal Improvements Assistance
Act, 1936

to create employment on productive
self-liquidating undertakings by providing municipalities with funds at low rate of interest;

basis anticipated increased net revenue sufficient to retire loan on amortization plan during useful life of project;

held that Dominion assistance which had effect of increasing burden of municipal taxpayers unjustifiable, hence aid restricted to self-liquidating projects.

Authorized aggregate principal of loans, \$30,000,000;

Interest 2% per annum, payable half-yearly; security represented by securities of municipality, in form approved by Dominion, equal to amount of loan.
