I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant, in regard to surrender of portion of the Fairford Reserve, and in reply to say that your visit to the Reserve may be postponed, as suggested, till the first week in May.

I may say that the Department has no information as to the rules of the Band in calling meetings, but what is required is only that the meeting be called in the usual mode of summoning meetings by the Indians.
