



Ottawa, February 10th., 1916.

Sir,

Referring to your letter of the 31st ultimo, I re-enclose herewith the voucher rendered at \$93.00 which you submitted covering your expense account for January, and I have to request that you will explain why payment should be requested in favor of Mrs. B. M. Jacquet for board from the 1st to the 12th January and from the 23rd to the 31st of that month, as according to the diary which you submit it would seem that you were ^{on your way to or} in Victoria on those dates. I have also to point out that the account from the Dominion Hotel which you submitted appears to be incorrect. There is a charge therein for board from the 13th to the 22nd January, while it would seem that you did not report to the Royal Commission in that city until the 20th January. An explanation is required before payment of the voucher can be considered.
