
Madam,-

In reply I beg to say that a communication has been received from Reverend Father Dugas regarding this matter and Mr. Agent McGregor was instructed to make full enquiries and report regarding the religious belief of the father.

No action will be taken to place these children in a residential school until the religious belief of the father has been fully established.
