And the sea no longer will be the scene of conflict, nor harbour any meance; it, too, will gladden the hearts of men as it unites, in friendly intercourse, the nations of the world.

Then, . . . "shall all men's good

Be each man's rule, and universal Peace

Lik like a shaft of light across the land,

And like a lane of beams athwart the sea,

Thro' all the circle of the golden year".

This new heaven, this new earth is the vision which, at this time of war, unites, inspires, and guides Britain, Canada, and other nations of the British Commonwealth, the United States and our allies in all parts of the world. No lesser vision will suffice to gain the victory. No lesser service to humanity will hold the faith and win the gratitude of mankind.
