"I visited the room in the Cafe where I interviewed Mde Julia Beyst the owner of the Cafe and room. I found on invest gation that the door of the room had been locked and that the thieves had gained admittance by breaking in the complete top I found on investipanel of the door to the room and forcing open the door of the wardrobe. The doors of the wardrobe which had also been locked had been pried open."

"On returnign to the detatchment a Cpl of the Pro Corps turned over to me the following articles:

7 Ladies' dresses 2 Light cloth coats

2 bottles of Cogane 2 Bottles of Picon Liqueur

I contacted Mde Beyst and she identified all these articles as her property. I handed them all back to her."

"I interviewed Pte Jones at the Guard Room of Leopold Bks on 8 Nov 44. I told him who I was and explained why I was interviewing him. I cautioned him that he need not say enything unless he wished to do so but whatever he did say would be taken down in writing and might be used as evidence. He told me that on the evening of the 7th Nov 44 he was with two other soldiers and they went into a lafe. He did not know the name of this lafe. He stated that the other two soldiers left the lafe beforehe did. He followed them and when in the hall inside the main door he say a lot of ladies' clothes and undermeath them were four hettles of lane. were four bottles of liquor. He said he picked up the clothes and bottles and carried them outside. He met the other two and walked with them down the street. He siad that he went with them into another cafe still carrying the clothes and when he came out he gave a dress to a girl whom he had never seen before. He also stated that a Provost Corps Jeep arrived and took him and the other two said are to their office. other two soldiers to their officer
